Warner's professional investigative work has received national recognition; awarded the Police and Fire Medal of Valor "Sustained Superiority" Award and the 2015 California Peace Officers Association COPSWEST Award for Cold-Case Investigation of the Year. Warner also continues to appear as an expert in a number of crime-based television series and is featured in God's Not Dead 2. He's part of a three-generation law enforcement family and has a Master's Degree in Theological Studies from Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary. Jim may also be recognized from NBC's Dateline, where he has appeared more than any other detective in the country.
